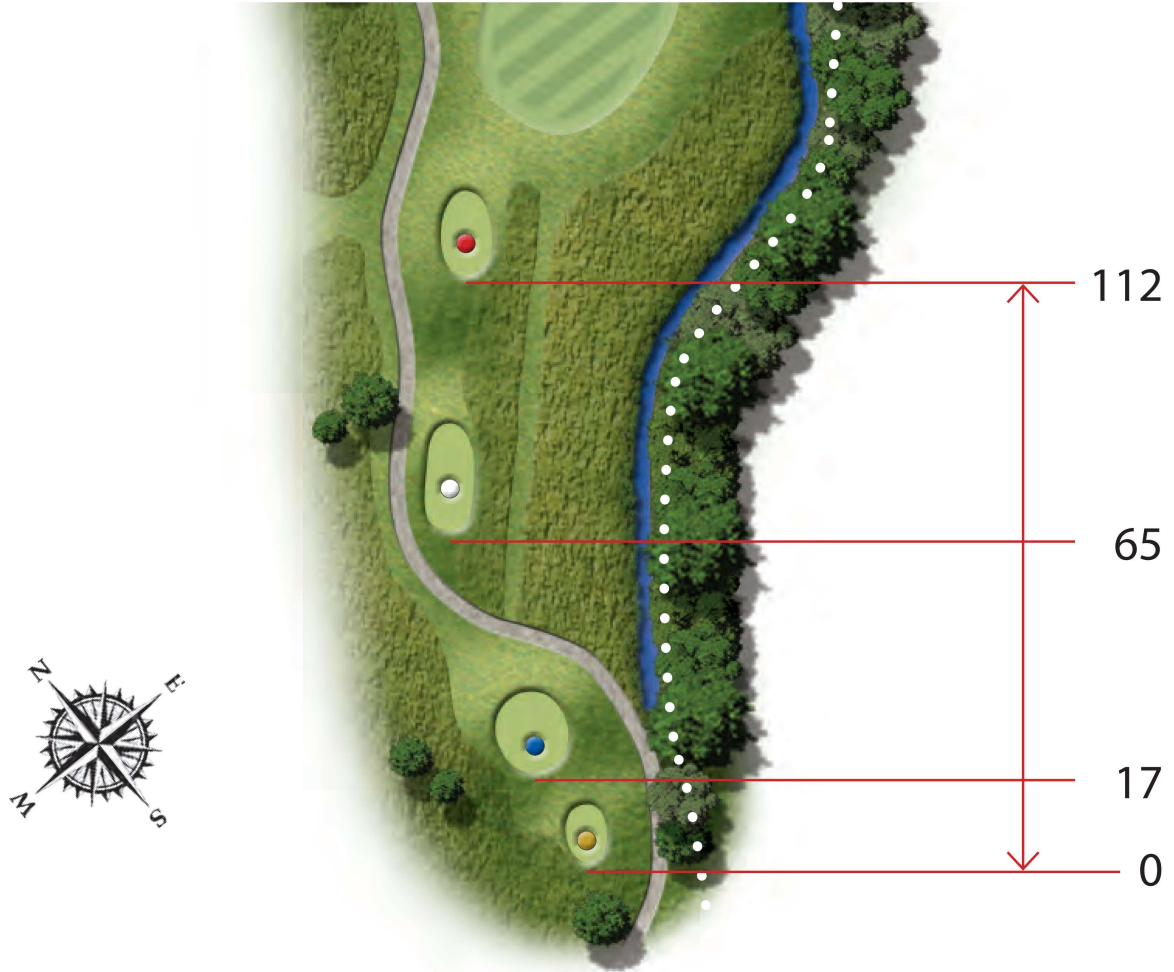

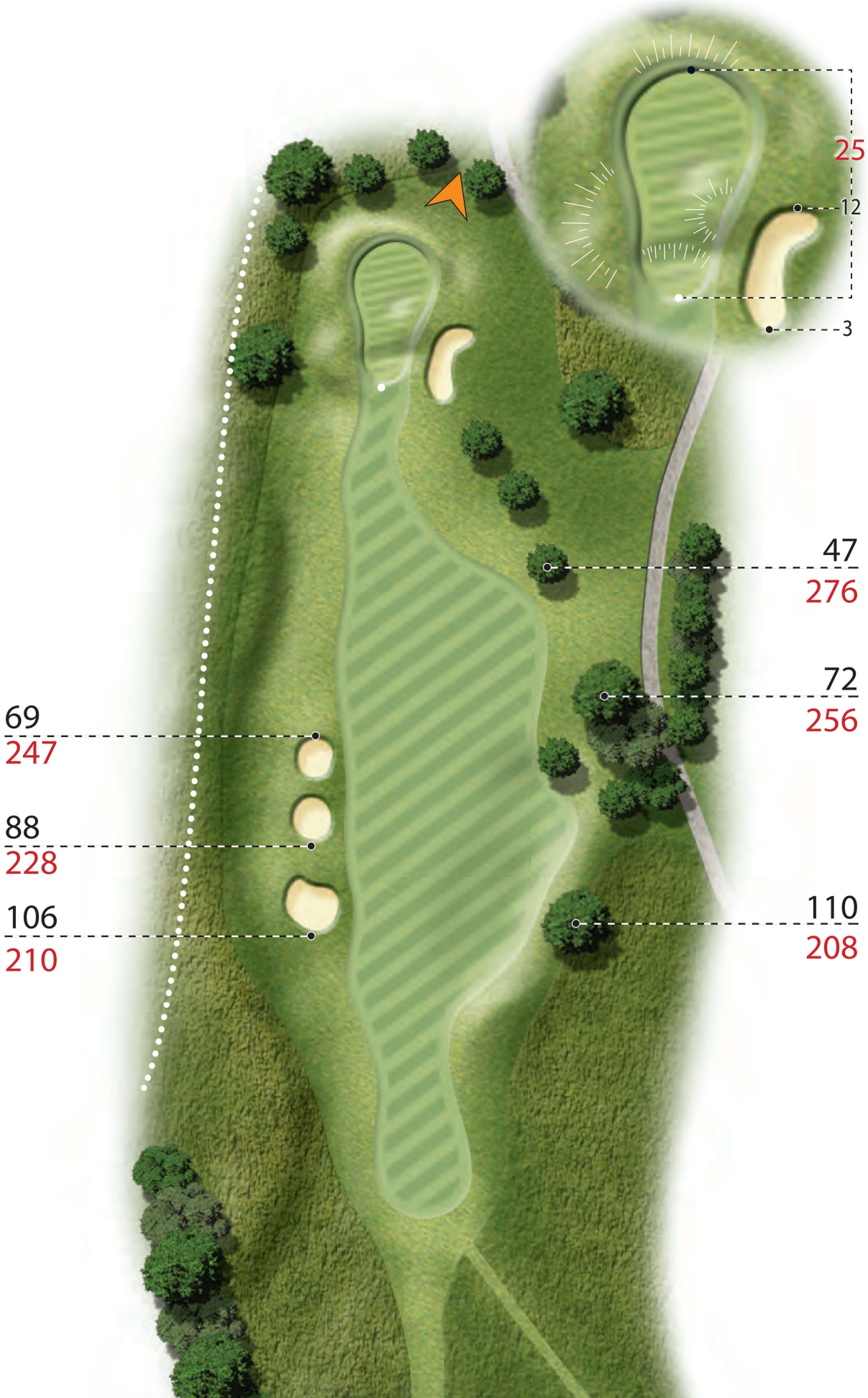
PAR 4 | STROKE INDEX 6

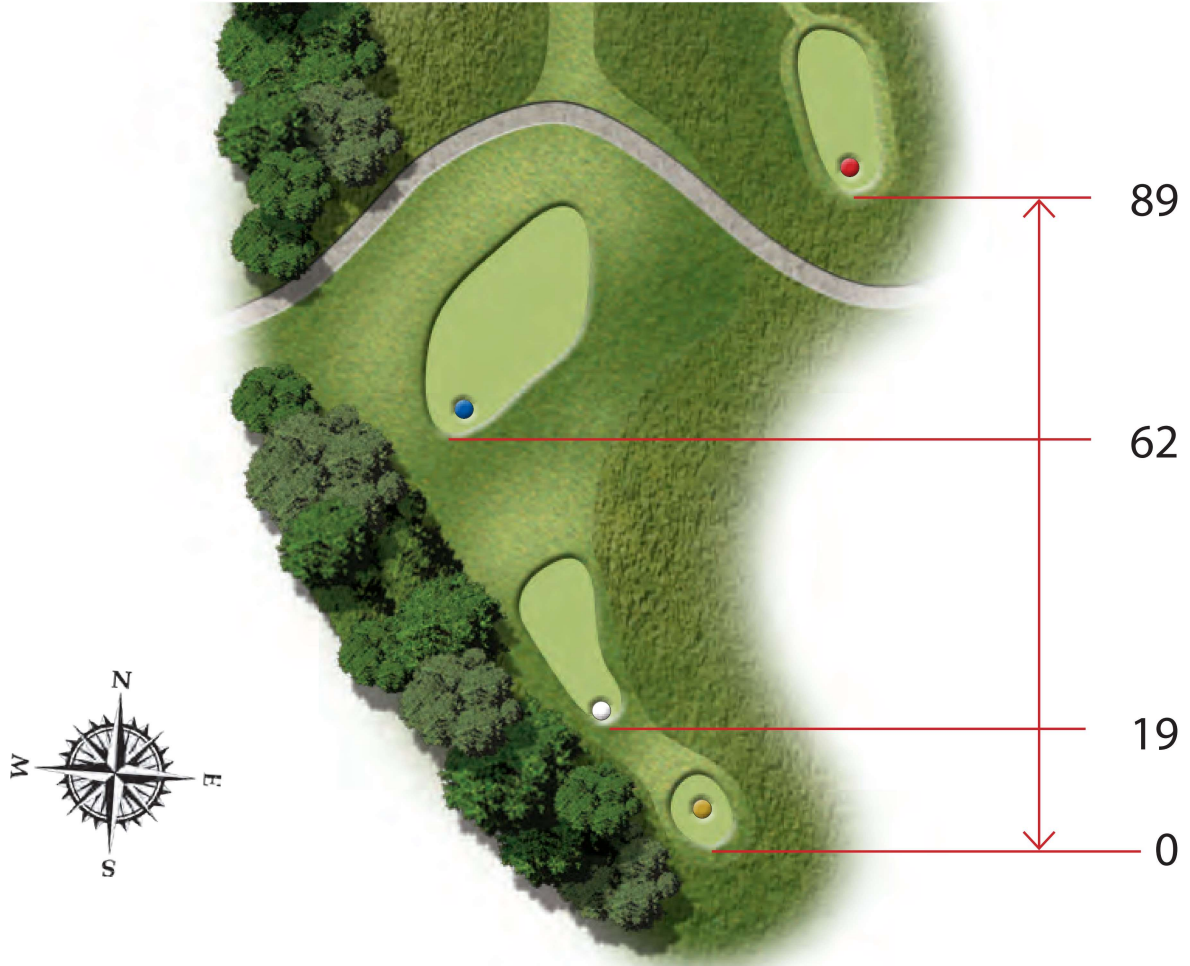
Aim down the middle but watch the ditch across the fairway for your next shot to a green that slopes from back to front.

## 6TH HOLE

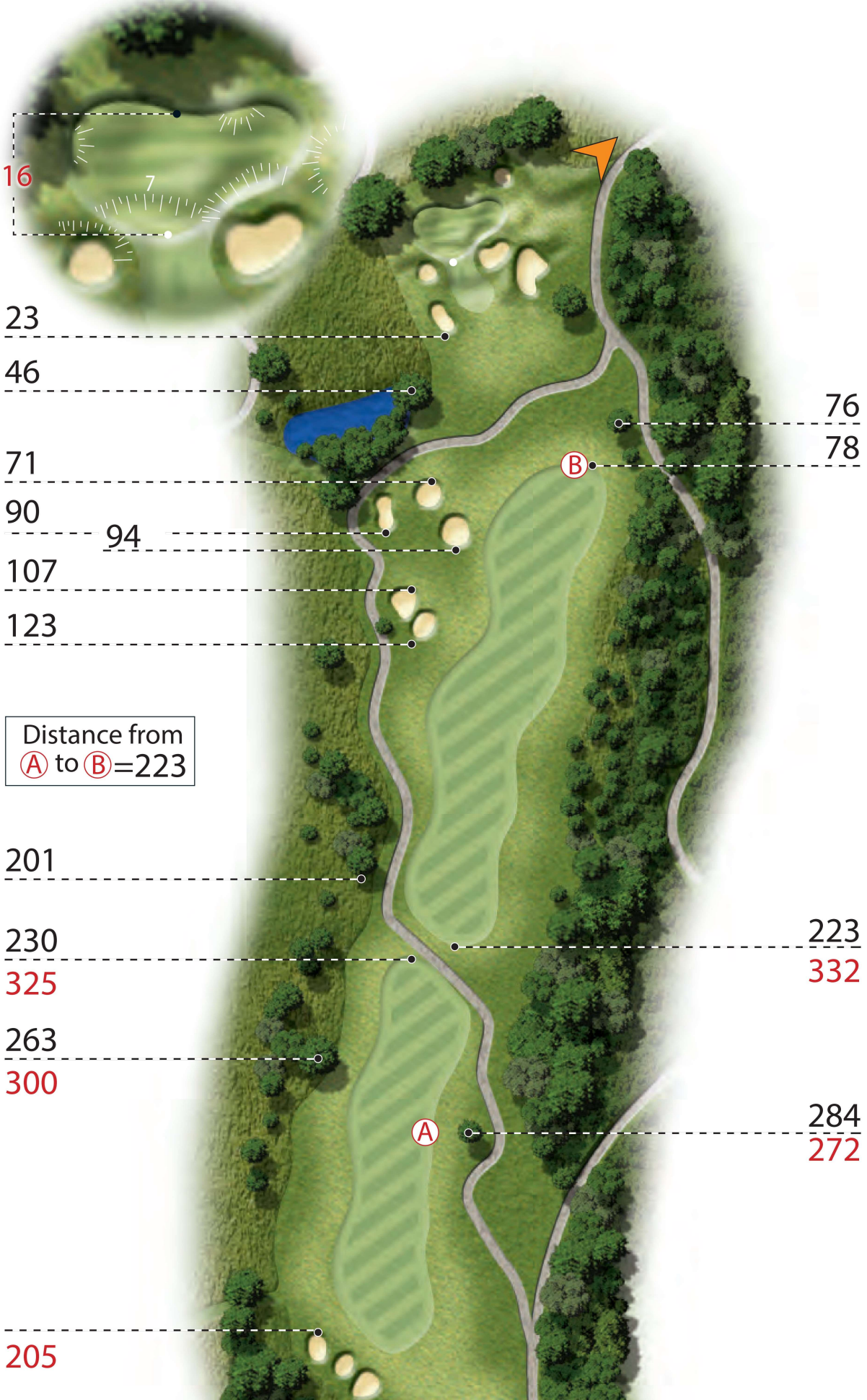
PAR 4 | STROKE INDEX 16

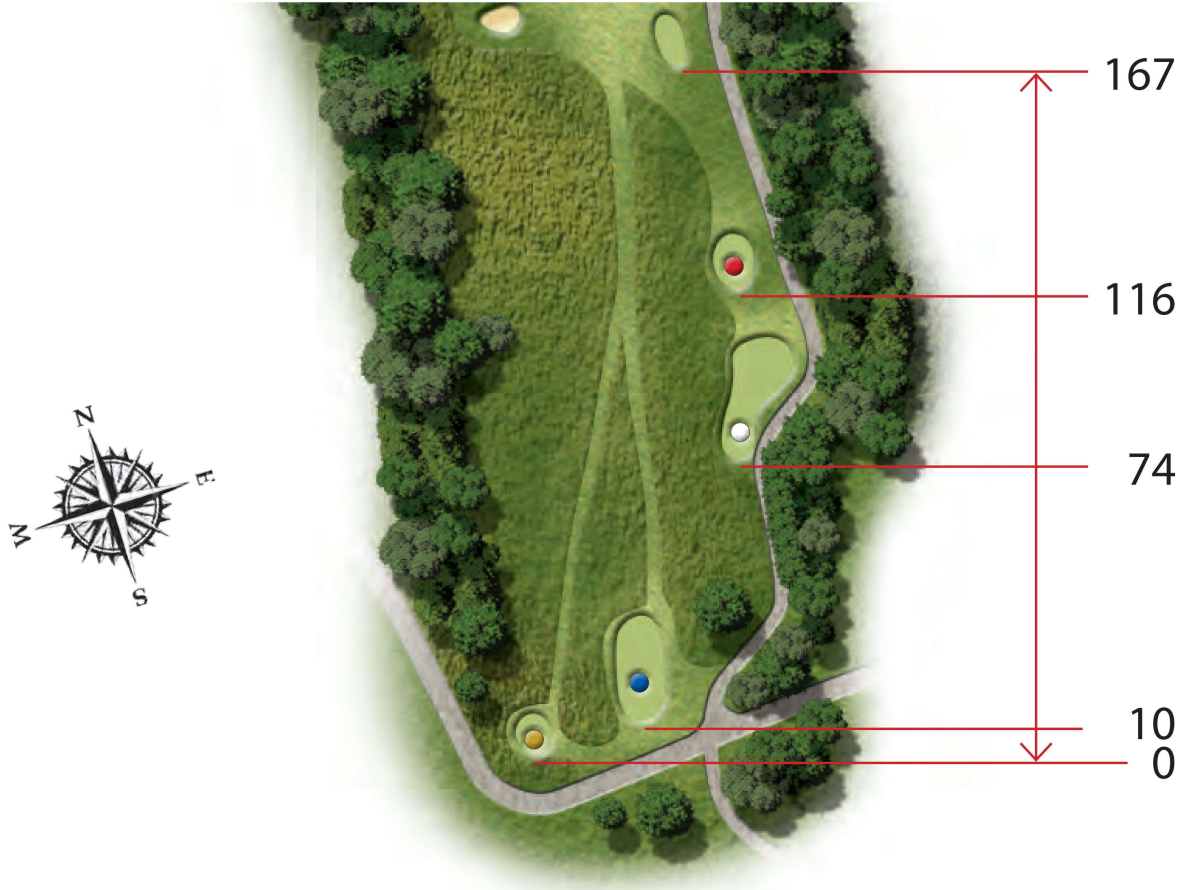
A short Par 4, favour the left half of the fairway avoiding the bunkers for the easiest approach to a narrow green.

PAR 5 | STROKE INDEX 2

A double dog-leg on this big Par 5. Cut the corners for the brave-hearted or be sure to lay up on the plateau for a safer 100 yard approach shot to a shallow green.

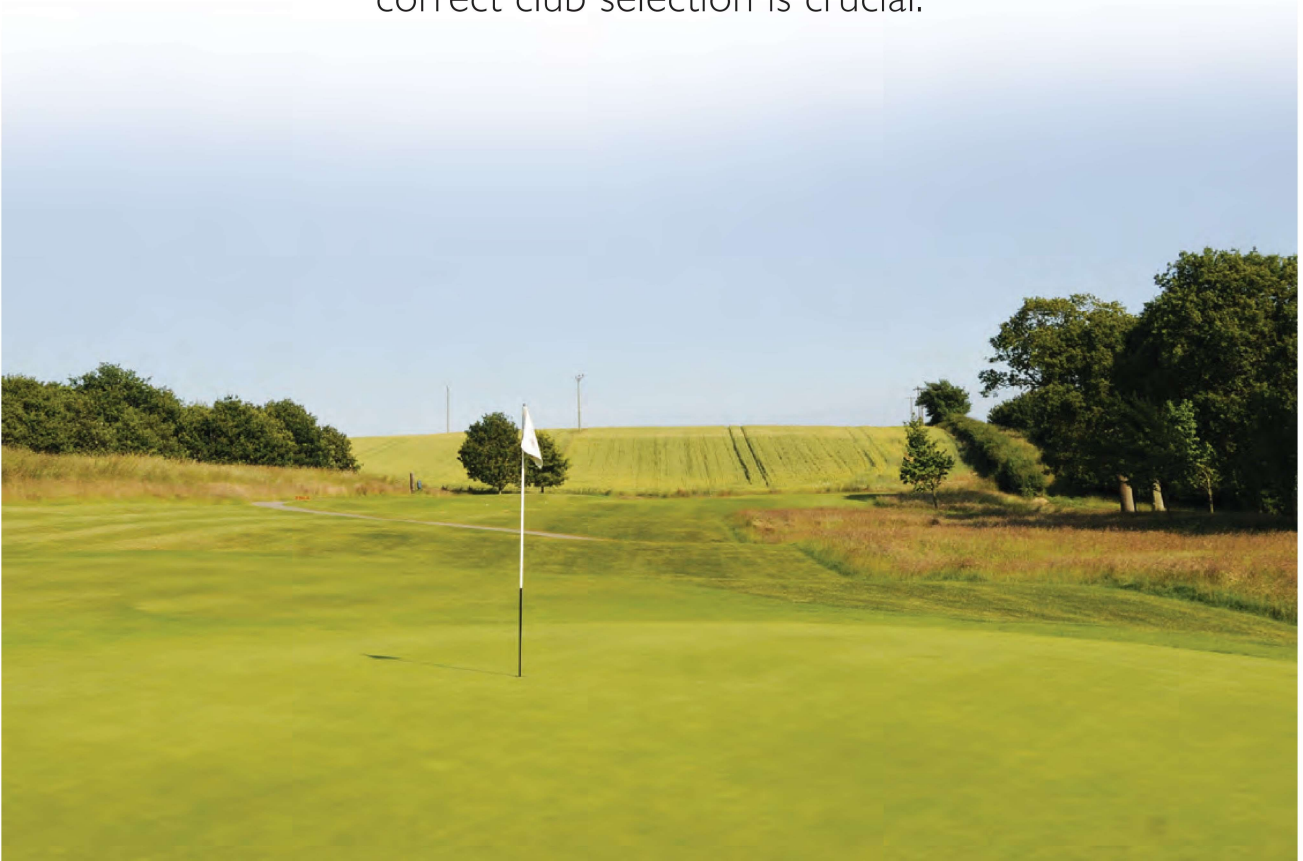

correct club selection is crucial.

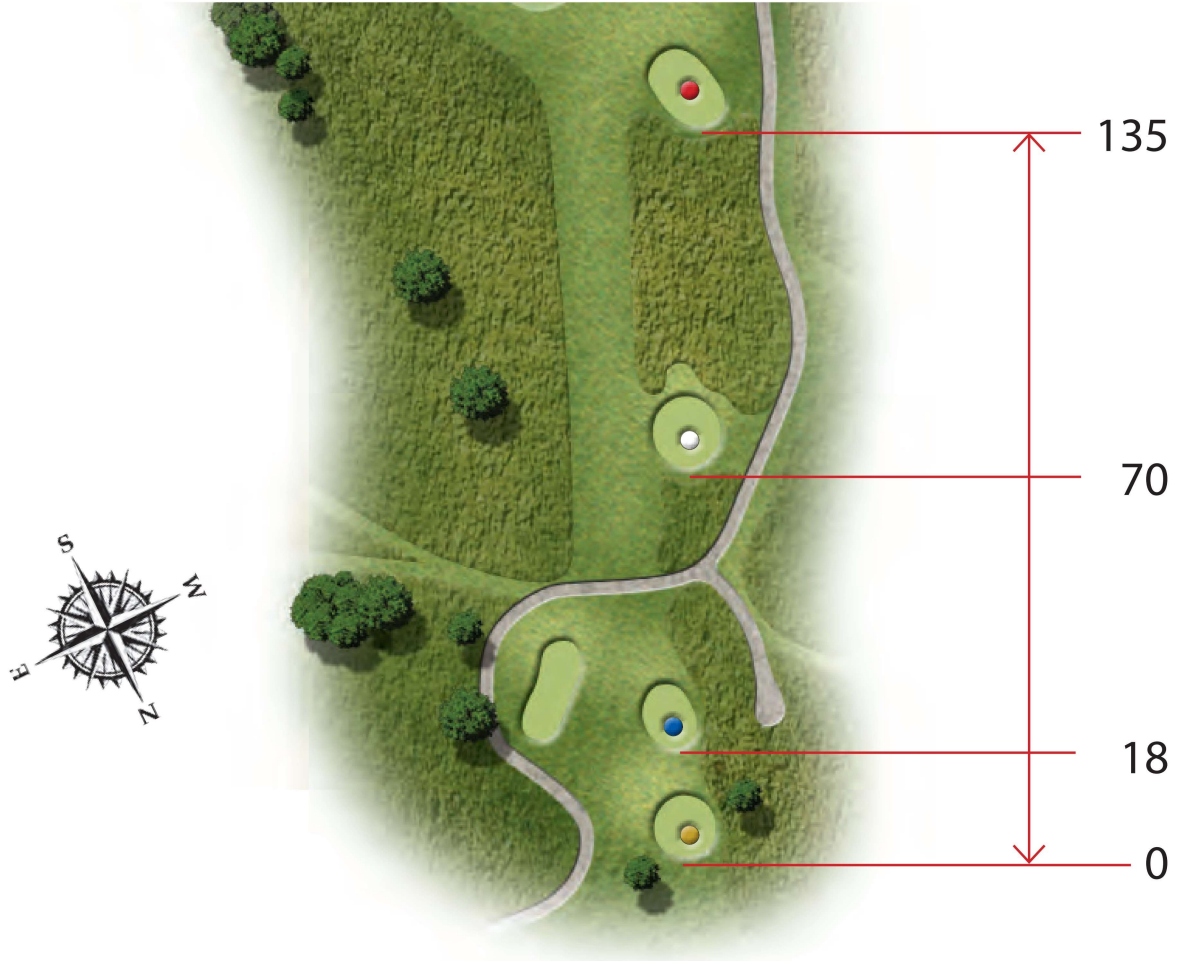

PAR 4 | STROKE INDEX 4

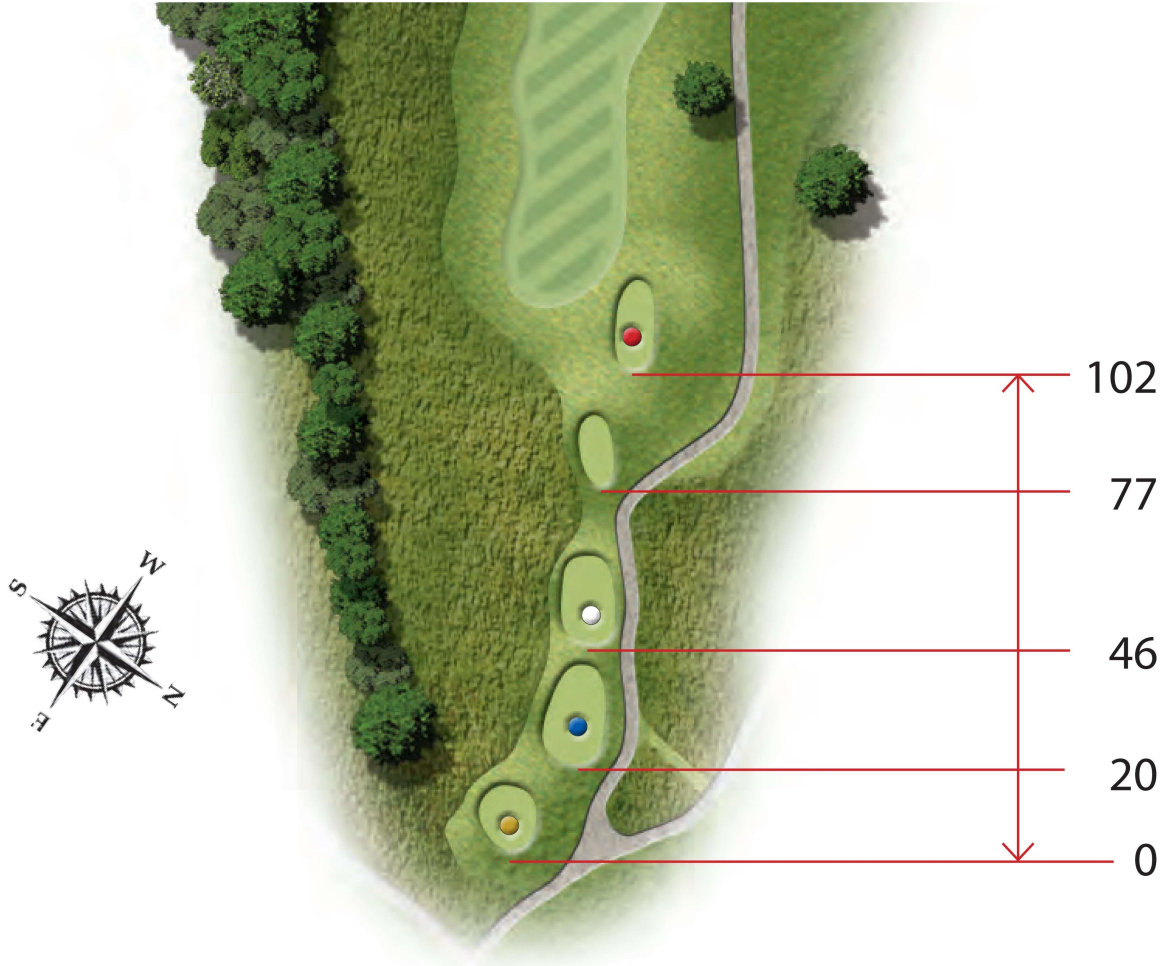
The best approach to this tough green is slightly from the left, so aim your drive accordingly. Watch the steep slope at the back of this undulating green.

PAR 5 | STROKE INDEX 5

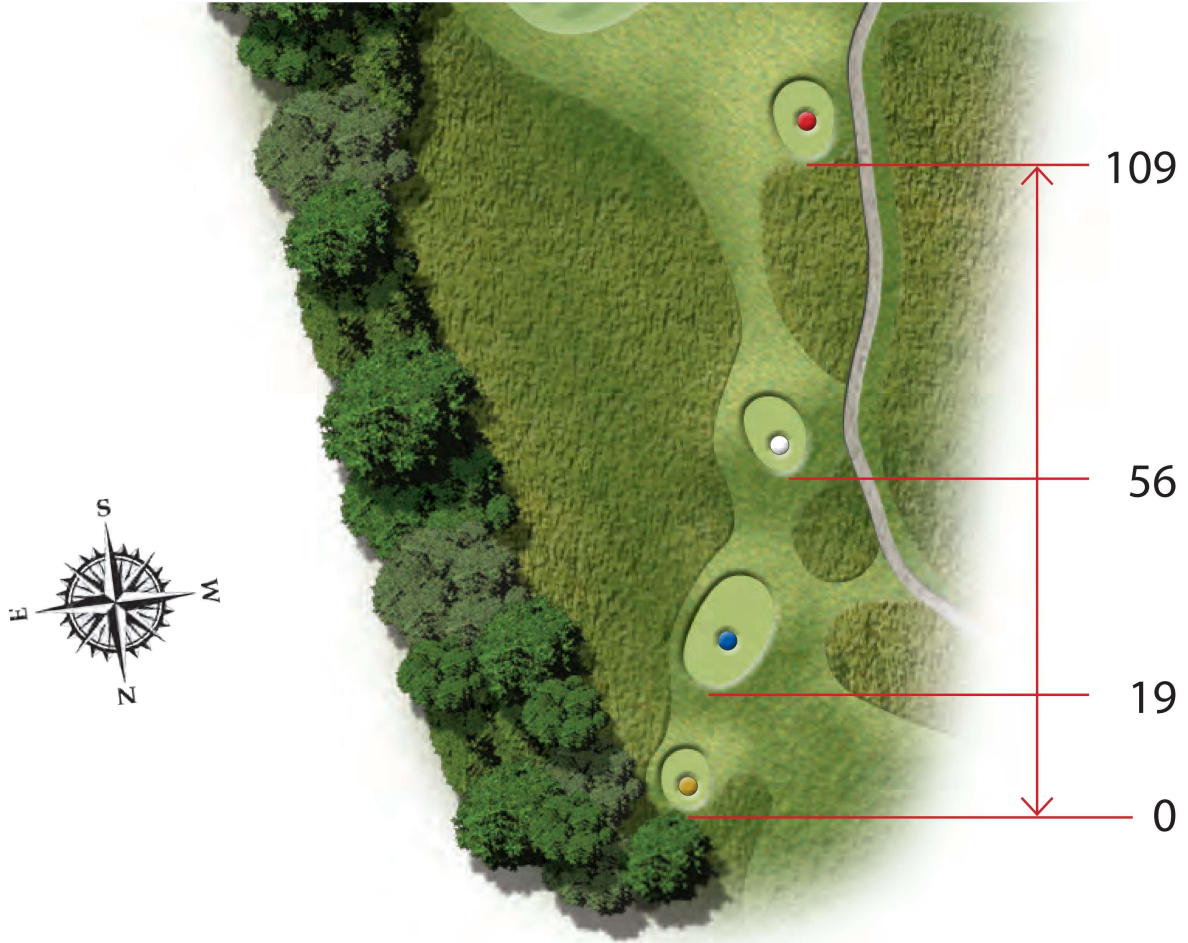
A blind drive right of centre will allow a bold second shot to the green or a sensible lay up short of the water.

## 11TH HOLE

PAR 4 | STROKE INDEX 7

Use the contours left of centre to maximize driving distance for an easier approach to a deep green. Check the pin position for clubbing.
