
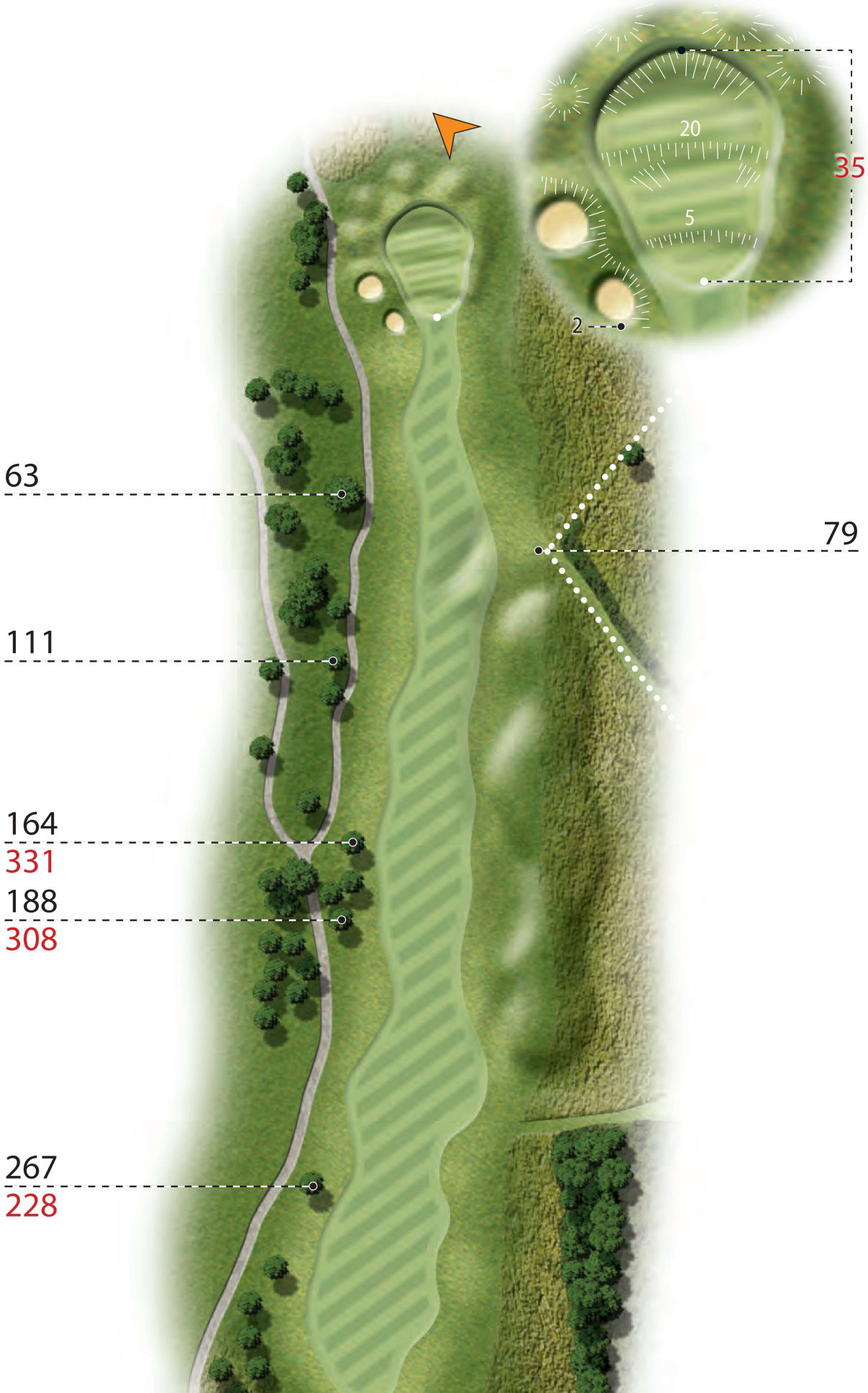
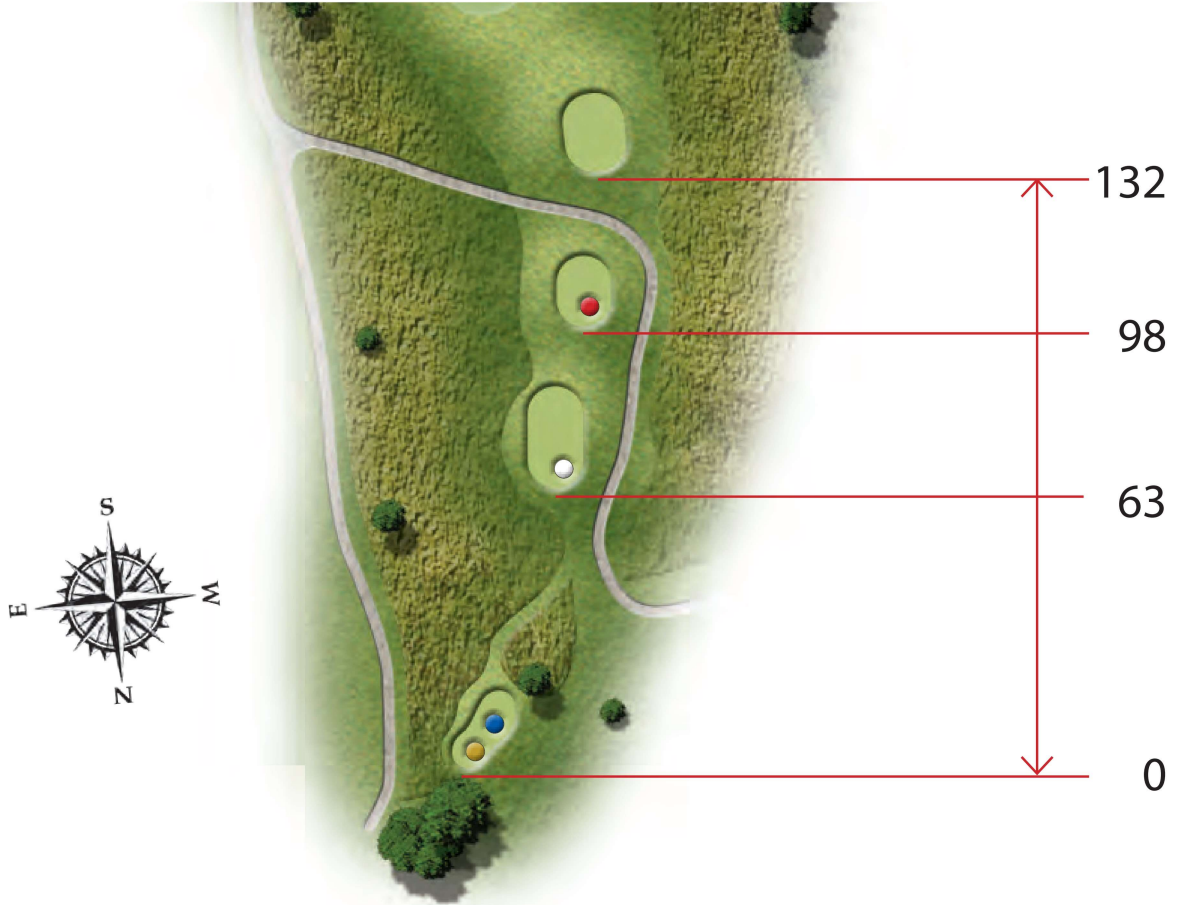

PAR 5 | STROKE INDEX 16

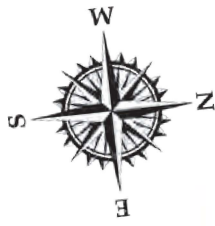
Straight with no fairway bunkers, this hole offers a good birdie chance. Check the pin position on this two tiered green.

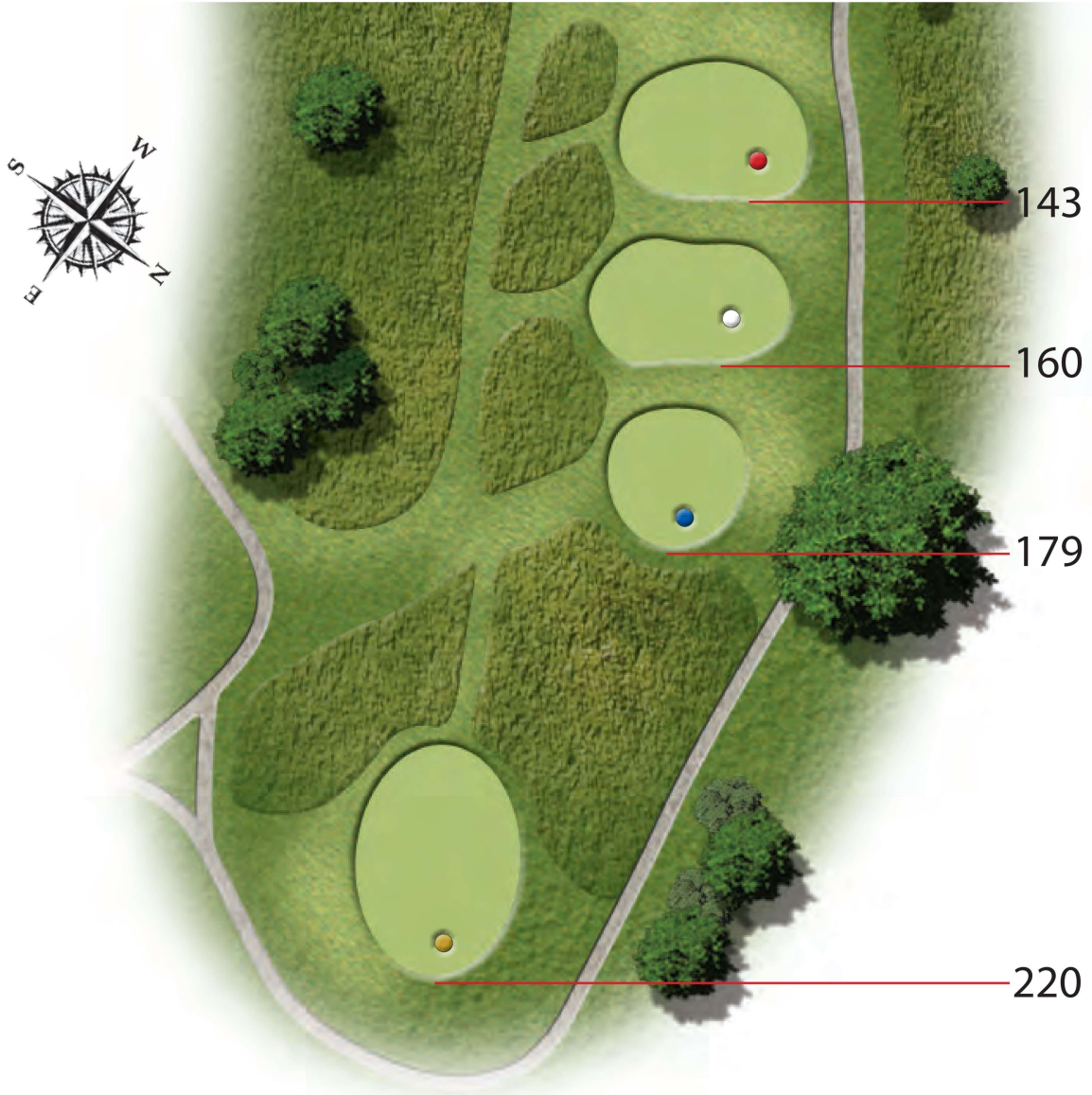

PAR 3 | STROKE INDEX 6

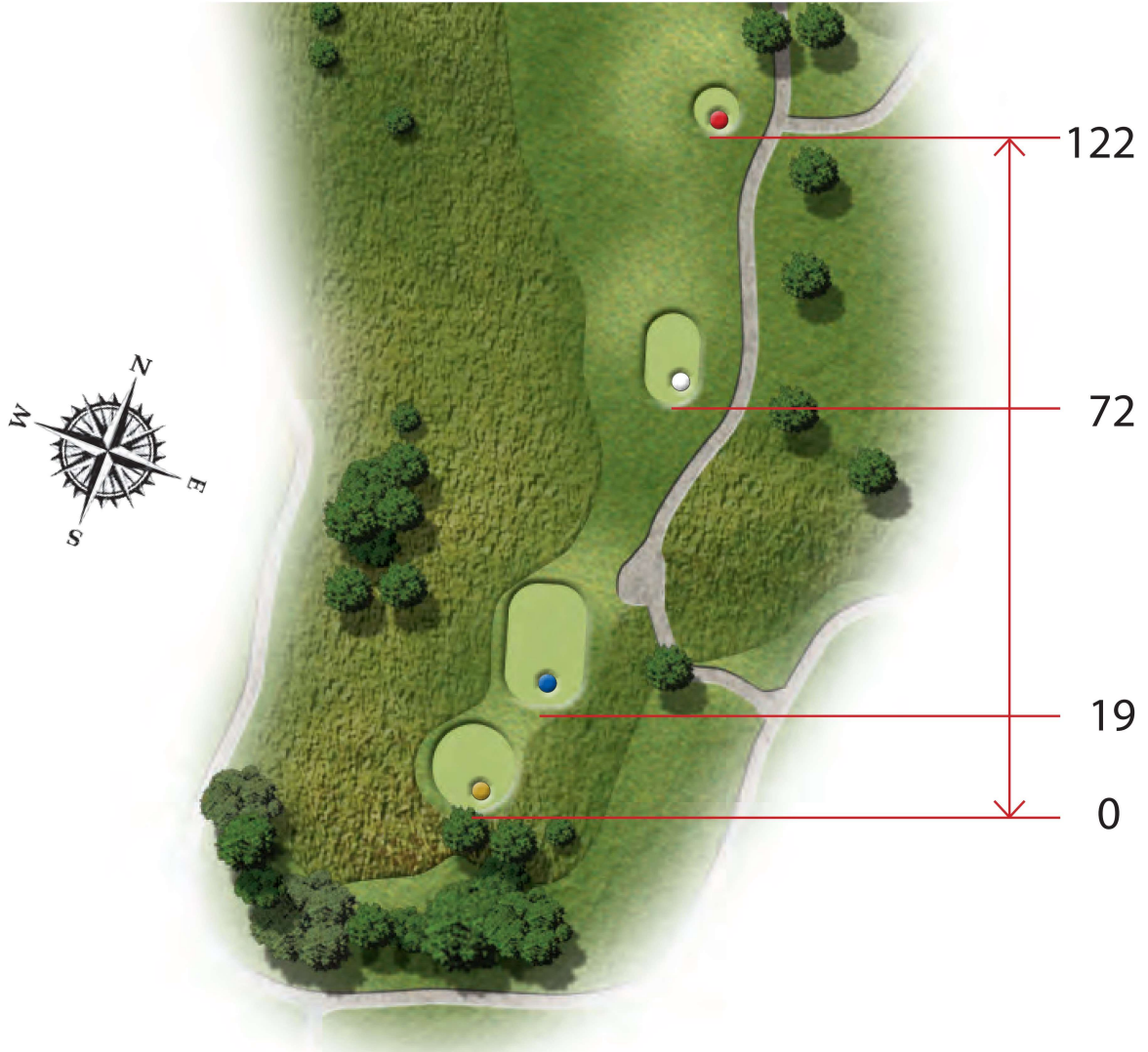
Take plenty of club to carry the bunkers which lie short of the green.

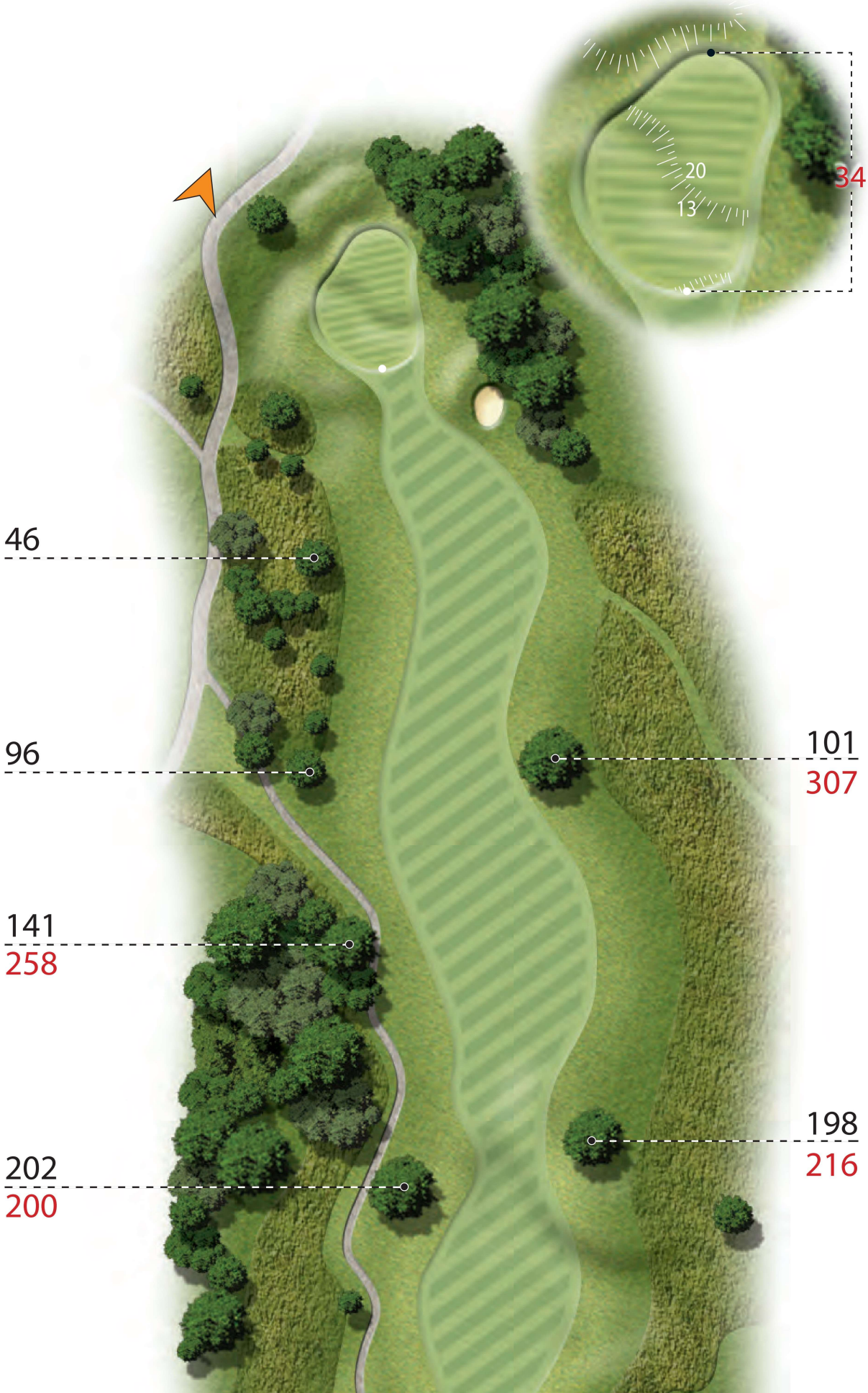
PAR 4 | STROKE INDEX 12

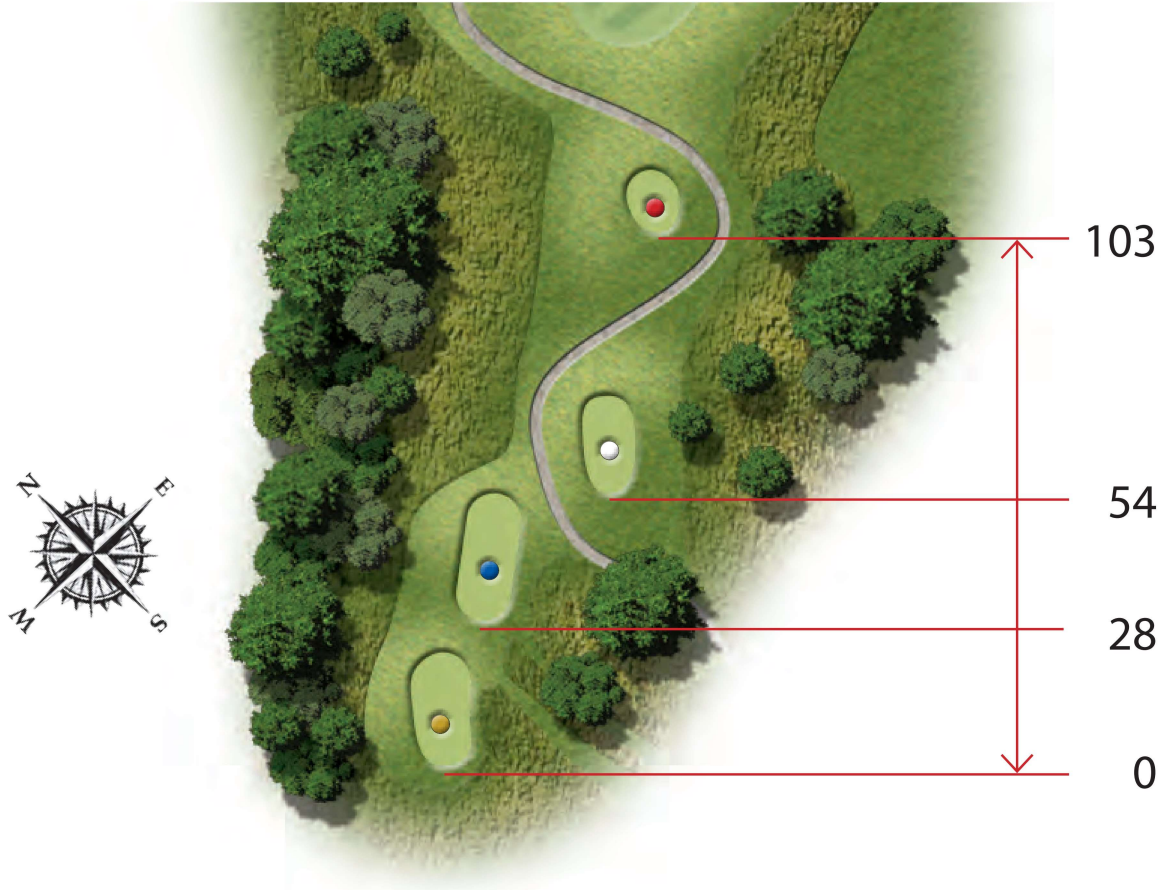
One of the easier driving holes.

PAR 4 | STROKE INDEX 2

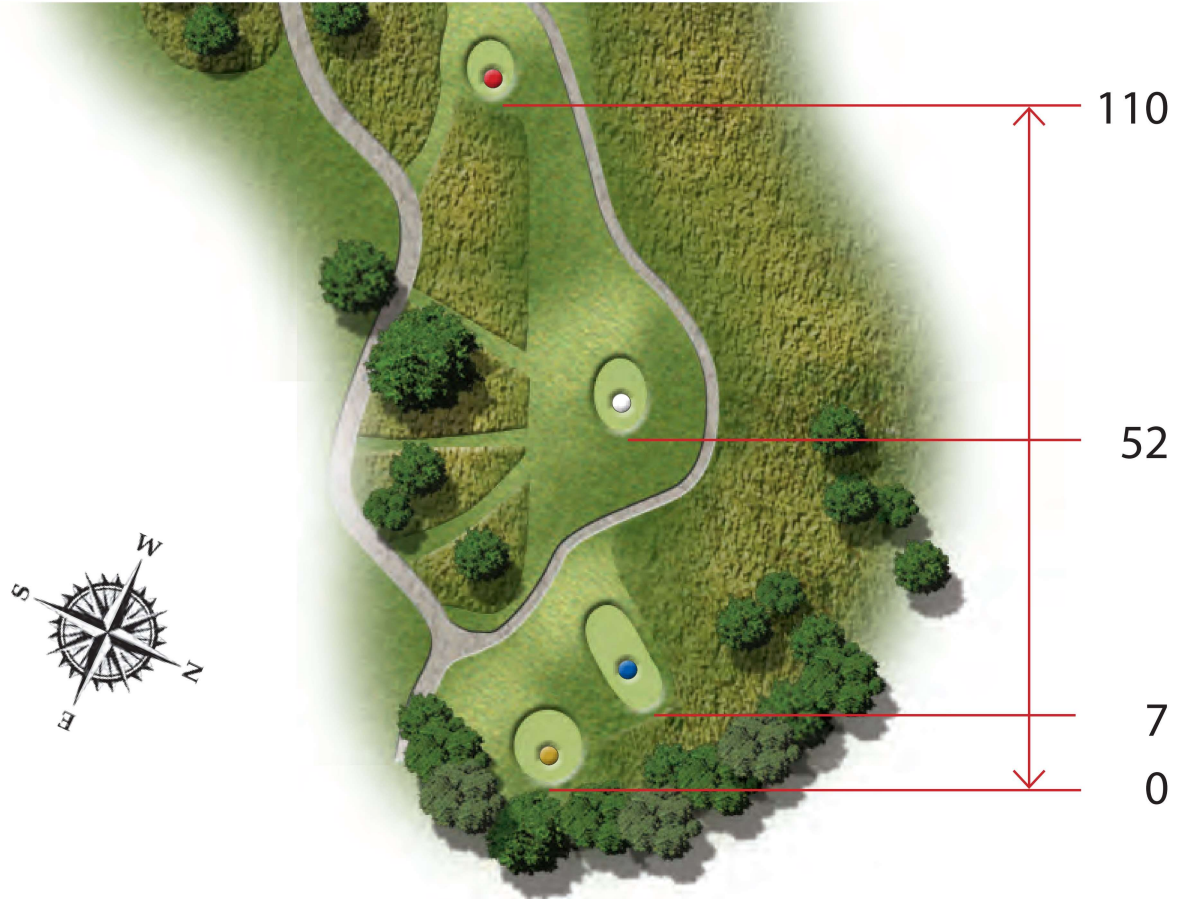
Aim slightly right of centre for the easiest approach to this tricky two tiered green.

PAR 4 | STROKE INDEX 7

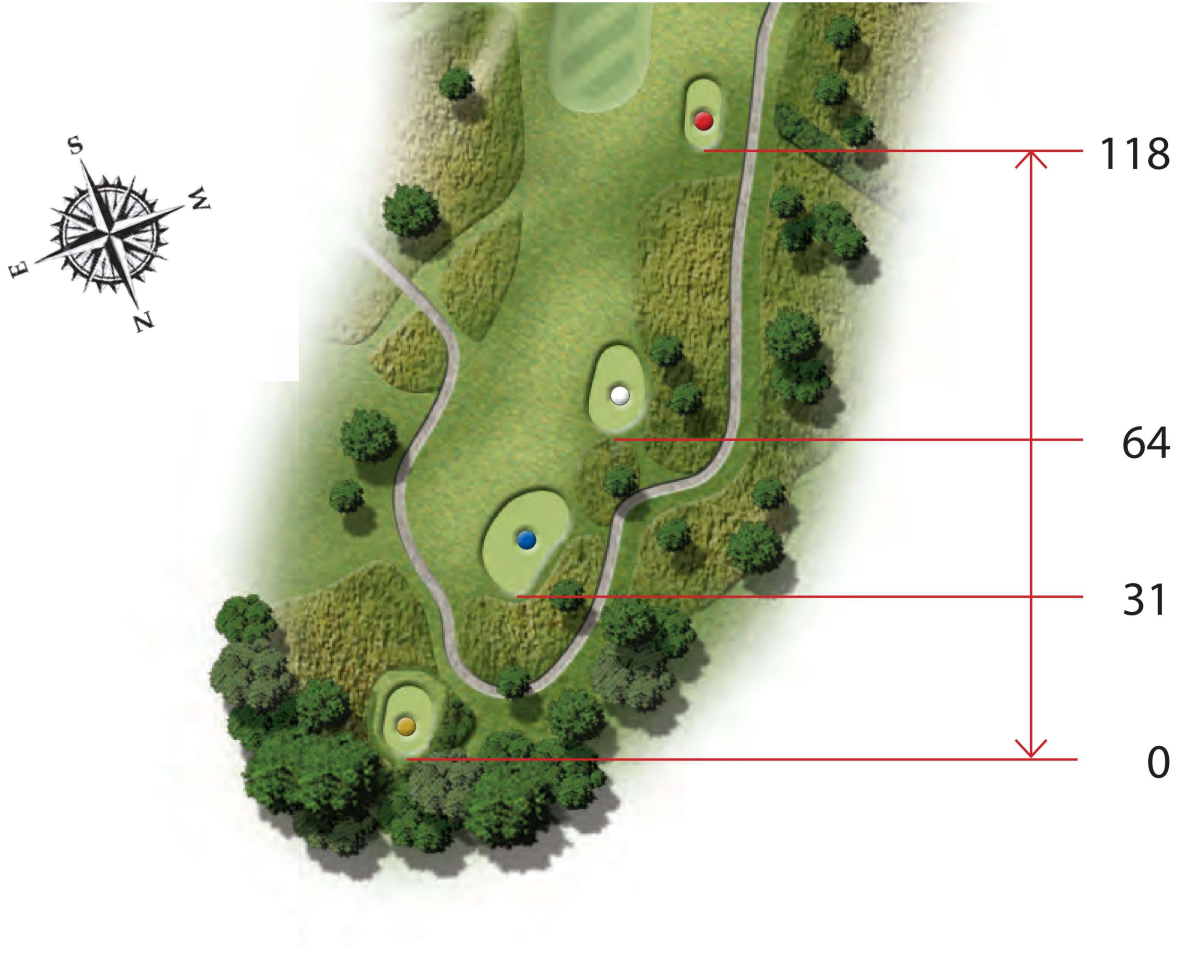
A bold drive close to the water makes for the easiest approach to this two tiered green. Alternatively bail out left down.
