# EAST SUSSEX NATIONAL GOLF CLUB LOCAL RULES

The rules of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews will apply.

## STAKED TREES

If a staked tree interferes with a player's stance or intended swing, relief must be taken under rule 16.1 (immovable obstructions).

## IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

Cart paths, hitchin rails, sprinklers, control boxes, starters huts, halfway houses & drain covers are immovable obstructions. Relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

## GROUND UNDER REPAIR

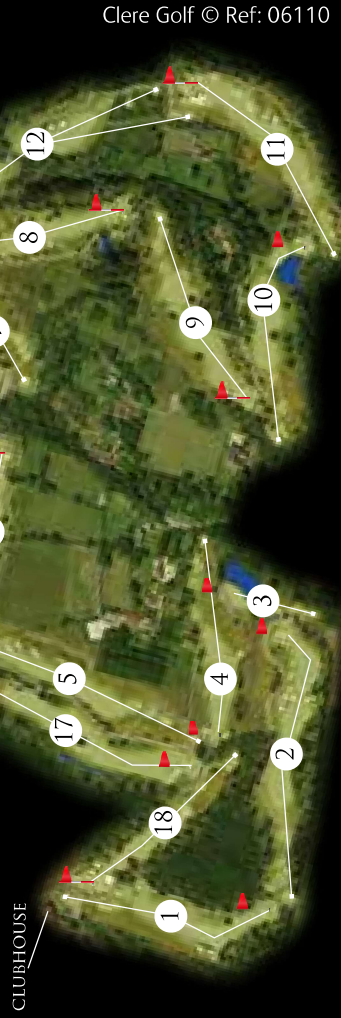
If a player's ball lies in an area of 'ground under repair' or such an area of 'ground under repair' interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 16.1.

## EXPOSED DRAINAGE LINES

If a player's ball lies in or on the lines, or interferes with the player's stance, relief may be taken without penalty by lifting and dropping the ball within one club-length not nearer the hole. Rule 16.1B abnormal ground conditions.

## ELECTRIC STORMS

In the event of lightning, the procedure is as follows when Klaxon is signalled by Club personnel:-

- 1 Prolonged Blast – stop play immediately, mark your ball and find nearest safe shelter
- 2 Short Blasts –resume play
- 3 Prolonged Blasts – return to club house as play has been suspended indefinitely

## Places of Shelter (West Course)

- Tunnel near 7th & 15th Holes, Halfway House & Club House.

Do not shelter under trees, power lines, metallic shelters, stand with or hold clubs, put up umbrella or use mobile phones.

If you continue to play golf, you do so entirely at your own risk. Play should not be resumed until you are advised that it is safe to do so.

Members should note that during Club Competitions, if lightning occurs, there are specific rules which apply as posted on a separate notice on the Notice Boards in the Locker Rooms. Please report any dangerous occurrences to Club staff.

**STONES IN BUNKERS** are movable obstructions (relief under Rule 12.2A).
