

GOLF VISITOR SAFETY INFORMATION

HAZARDS :-

- Lakes / Water Hazards
- Chemical Spraying
- Buggies
- Flying Objects – Golf Balls
- Flying Objects - Debris
- Weather
- Terrain
- Public Footpaths

CONTROLS :-

- Lakes / Water Hazards
 - These are clearly defined with red posts
 - Do not go into water to retrieve or search for golf balls
- Chemical Spraying
 - Please observe safety signage
 - Request change of golf course if concerned for safety
 - Request data sheets or information from club
 - Do not lick golf balls
- Buggies
 - Drive safely
 - Do not drive under the influence of alcohol
 - Observe signage
 - Fitted with gps systems , these must not be deactivated.
- Flying Objects – Golf Balls
 - Do not hit balls in the direction of others
 - Staff have priority
 - Shout ‘four’ as a warning for stray shots
 - Be careful if walking on adjoining holes
 - Do not walk ahead of other players
- Flying Objects – Debris
 - Do not walk near greenkeeping activities
 - Observe all signage
- Weather
 - Ensure that you are dressed appropriately to conditions

- Ensure that you have means to hydrate
 - Use sun cream
- Terrain
 - Wear appropriate footwear
 - Walk carefully in all areas
 - Avoids slopes where possible
- Public Footpaths
 - Walkers have right of way
 - Adhere to signage

YOUR RESPONSIBILITY :-

- Be responsible for your own safety
- Report any dangerous occurrences
- Never hit a ball in the direction of anyone
- Drive all vehicles safely
- Avoid walking on slopes , even if it is the shortest distance
- Wear correct footwear.
- Ensure that you have sufficient water , food and any medicines required
- Dress in appropriate clothing to the conditions and leave the course if you are feeling unwell.
- Do not play if you think conditions are not safe.
